- Self-builders who are organising everything themselves.

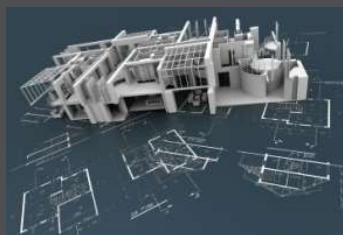
